Inappropriate Content – How to be Safe in Reality?



- Don't accept rides from friends without telling a guardian first.
- Always say no if a friend offers you drugs or cigarettes, especially if you're underage.
- Do the **smart** thing. Using drugs puts your health, education, family ties and social life at risk.

Cyber Safety refers to practices and precautions you should observe and consider doing when using the Internet, so as to ensure your personal safety.

Inappropriate Content – Definition



Inappropriate content is that which breaches norms or standards on social, religious, cultural or other grounds.

Important! Inappropriate doesn't necessarily mean illegal.

Inappropriate Content – Without Seeking, How Could Someone Run Into Inappropriate Content?



- Unexpected results from online searches i.e. Google.
- Clicking wrong links or pop-up.
- An Upsetting comment on a social networking site.
- Mistyping a website address.
- Unmoderated chat rooms.

We should stay away from that!

- Video Sharing sites and forums.
- Gambling or pornography sites (out of curiosity).
- Violent or pornographic images.





Inappropriate Content – How Harmful Can It Be?



- Changes your mindset.
- Misleads you.
- Hurts you feelings.

Be Careful!

- Deceives your mindset about religion.
- Takes you in the wrong direction!



Inappropriate Content – Is It Inappropriate Or Illegal For All?




- Illegal content in some regions may not be illegal in others, and hence, they can not be removed.
- Inappropriate content may be appropriate for some cultures.







Inappropriate Content – So, What's Our Problem?



- There are tons of inappropriate sites that are being added online everyday.
- There is no way we can do anything to block that.
- We can easily get exposed to inappropriate content these days through ads, TV programs, third party sites.





Inappropriate Content – What We Can Do?



- Evaluate Site content:
 - Is it a reputable site.
 - Does it provide useful information.
 - Is it relevant and appropriate to your age.
 - Does it have contact information available for reach.
 - Enable Safe Search on Search Engines i.e. Google.

- On Social Networking sites, report inappropriate comment or post to the site administrator i.e. on Facebook.
- Enable Safety Mode on YouTube.
- Don't open links from people you don't know.
