Salem Takes Safety Measures





BEFORE YOU READ

Before reading **Salem Takes Safety Measures**, ask the children some questions on what they expect the comic to be about based on the title and the cover page.

- What do you predict this comic to be about?
- What kind of safety measures might Salem be taking?



WHILE YOU READ

While reading the comic, make a **poof sound** when Rayyan and Hakeem appear, pointing at them, then mention their names.

Change your voice whenever you switch between characters. When Hakeem is speaking, use a skeptic tone. When Rayyan is speaking, use an energetic, enthusiastic tone.

Make sure to morph your facial expression to mimic that of the characters. For example, when Salem is telling the strange man to leave, show a displeased expression on your face.



AFTER YOU READ

After you've finished reading the comic, ask the children some questions to gauge their understanding. Some questions you can pose would be:

- What did the man who showed up at Salem's house say he wanted?
- Did you believe what the man said at first about Ali sending him to pick up Salem?
- How does Salem make sure whether the man is telling the truth or not?
- If you were in Salem's position, how would you have handled such a situation?
- What did you learn from what happened with Salem?



BEYOND THE COMIC

Social engineering is when people get manipulated into giving up confidential information. Social engineering attacks pose a huge threat to our online presence and data at this age and time. Below are some examples of social engineering scenarios.

Explain the concept to your child and discuss with them the scenarios presented. **What is being asked here? What is the problem with this request? What is the best decision in their opinion?**

You get a message informing you that you won that new gaming console you've been wanting. All you have to do is click the link in the message.			
You get an email from what seems to be the makers of your favorite video game. They ask you to insert your dad's credit card details because they claim your session has expired.			
You get a message from an unfamiliar number claiming to be one of your classmates. They tell you they got a new number, and that they need you to give them your address since they want to stop by during the weekend.
